Having spent six months in Tilonia, India, Mariama Bamba and her six fellow Senegalese participants came back equipped with the skills necessary to install, maintain, and repair solar panels for more than 50 households in each of their communities. They will now begin the work they were trained to do: providing light and power to hundreds of people in the coming months.

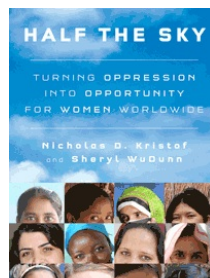
Abandonment of female genital cutting (FGC)
